WARM-UPS

The saying goes "better late than never," and that certainly applies to the Bellarmine University women's basketball team's Saturday afternoon contest against No. 2 Louisville in the KFC Yum! Center.

The Knights and Cardinals were able to re-schedule the game after originally slating it for Dec. 6. It was among the many nationally that had to be postponed amidst the chaos created by the pandemic. Both teams have felt the effects. Louisville's most recent three games — all ACC contests — were put on hold, leaving the Cardinals without an opponent since a 73-49 road win at Duke on Dec. 9. Bellarmine's Monday home game against Morehead State has been postponed. When the Knights take the floor against the Cardinals, they'll have played one game over the last two weeks.

Due to consistent matchups from the early 1970s through the mid-'80s, Bellarmine and Louisville have squared off 18 times, with the Cardinals holding a 14-4 advantage in the series.

While Bellarmine is 0-4 this season, its margin of defeat has decreased in every game, most recently a 72-62 loss at Evansville in which the Knights nearly erased an 18-point third-quarter deficit as they rallied back to within two with four minutes left in the final period before the Aces turned them back.

KNIGHT INSIGHTS

- Separated just miles apart, Bellarmine and Louisville share the same city and, historically, are familiar with each other on the court. The Knights and Cardinals have met on 18 occasions, with 17 of those contests occurring from the 1971-72 to 1984-85 seasons. Louisville owns a 14-4 series lead and captured the most recent clash, 80-56, at home on Dec. 16, 1999. Bellarmine and Louisville split the last four games in the series.
- This season marks the first with iconic Freedom Hall as Bellarmine's home venue. Freedom Hall was previously home to Louisville for five decades.
- Bellarmine features a host of players from the city of Louisville in Breia Torrens, Tasia Jeffries, Ashlee Harris, Lauren Deel and Danielle Feldkamp. Senior guards and co-captains Torrens and Jeffries won a pair of Kentucky high school state titles together at Butler Traditional.
- After missing the team's first three games, Jeffries made her season debut Tuesday at Evansville and scored a team-high 17 points behind three 3-pointers. Jeffries was a third-team All-GLVC selection in Bellarmine's final season in Division II.
- Junior guard Presley Brown set a new career high with seven rebounds against Evansville and matched a career best with 10 points.
- Torrens returned to the lineup Dec. 19 against Western Illinois after missing the team's first two games and scored a game-high 19 points. Torrens was among 10 players selected to the ASUN's Preseason All-Conference Team after earning first-team All-GLVC accolades last season.
- Bellarmine is the newest member of the ASUN Conference and officially gained entrance to the league on July 1.
- Bellarmine's entrance to the ASUN is actually a return for Coach Chancellor Dugan. She was the head coach at former league member Florida Atlantic for 13 seasons before taking over the Knights.

**ABOUT LOUISVILLE**

- Louisville is 5-0 and ranked second in the Associated Press poll. Due to the pandemic, the Cardinals' last three games had been postponed, leaving their last contest a 73-49 win at Duke on Dec. 9. Dana Evans scored 24 points for Louisville as the Cardinals pulled away from the Blue Devils with an 18-5 run starting about midway through the third quarter. Kianna Smith added 15 points for Louisville.
- Dana Evans is among the most heralded players in the country. The senior guard was named to the John R. Wooden Award Preseason Top 30 Watch List along with being selected as the ACC Preseason Player of the Year, an Associated Press Preseason All-American, and to the Naismith and Drysdale Award Watch List.
- Guard Hailey Van Lith was named ACC Freshman of the Week on Nov. 30 after averaging 16.5 points and 9.5 rebounds in her first two games at Louisville.

**BELLARMINE JOINS DIVISION I**

On July 1, 2020, Bellarmine University celebrated the elevation of its athletics program from NCAA Division II to NCAA Division I, making Bellarmine the only private DI university in Kentucky and one of only a handful of DI Catholic universities in the South.

All 22 of the Knights' varsity sports programs now compete in Division I, including 17 in the ASUN Conference.

Bellarmine's move to DI was announced in the summer of 2019 as one of the first major initiatives in the university's strategic plan. Stakeholder studies revealed the university and its student-athletes were well-poised for DI competition. Transitioning to DI extends the university's geographic reach, supports enrollment growth, improves diversity and achieves better gender balance. Increased exposure enhances institutional awareness and expands partnership opportunities.

Bellarmine teams in the following 17 sports will compete in the ASUN, beginning in the 2020-21 academic year: baseball, men's and women's basketball, men's and women's cross country, men's and women's golf, men's and women's soccer, softball, men's and women's tennis, men's and women's indoor and outdoor track and field and volleyball. Men's lacrosse, which has been a DI program since 2005, will continue as a member of the Southern Conference; wrestling has also joined the Southern Conference; men's and women's swimming will participate in the Coastal Collegiate Sports Association; field hockey will join the Mid-American Conference beginning in 2021-22.

NEW HOME IN FREEDOM HALL

As they prepared for their inaugural season in NCAA Division I, the Bellarmine University's women's and men's basketball teams announced they would play their home games in iconic Freedom Hall under a multiyear partnership with Kentucky Venues.

Bellarmine's entire athletics program was elevated to NCAA Division I this summer, with most teams, including the basketball programs, playing in the ASUN Conference. The Knights will now call Freedom Hall - one of college basketball's most storied venues - their home.

With the COVID-19 pandemic limiting seating capacity for the 2020-21 season, Bellarmine began looking for alternate venues for its home basketball games.

Bellarmine Athletic Director Scott Wiegandt said that "Freedom Hall was a natural choice as it's steeped in rich basketball tradition and is minutes from our campus."

"We then saw the obvious benefits of making Freedom Hall a more long-term home for our basketball programs," Wiegandt said. "It has long been considered one of the best places in the world to watch a basketball game and the venue gives us ample room to grow into our new D-I status."

The 18,252-seat Freedom Hall can accommodate 2,700 fans this season under Kentucky Gov. Andy Beshear's recommendation of capping attendance at 15 percent capacity to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

By comparison, Knights Hall seats 2,196 and would have been restricted to just over 300 fans this season. The basketball floor mirrors the one in Knights Hall, which will remain in use for practice and select games. Bellarmine has also added branding throughout Freedom Hall that ensures players and fans feel at home.

Located in the Kentucky Exposition Center and operated by the Kentucky Venues, Freedom Hall has completed numerous upgrades recently that enhances the fan experience, including new lighting in the concourse and arena, renovated suites, state-of-the-art display on the center-hung digital scoreboard and a cutting-edge sound system.

2020-21 OUTLOOK: After a long and rich history in Division II, the Bellarmine University women's basketball team is set to enter a new era. The 2020-21 season represents the first in Division I for Bellarmine, which joined the ASUN Conference after previously being a founding member of DII's Great Lakes Valley Conference.

Bellarmine exited DII after making 16 appearances in the NCAA II Tournament, four of which included trips to the Elite Eight and one (1994) of which extended into the Final Four. The Knights were a fixture in the GLVC Tournament, earning a spot in the event in all 23 years of its existence while capturing the 2016 championship under Head Coach Chancellor Dugan.

In 2019-20, Bellarmine went 18-11 and made the GLVC Tournament semifinals for the fourth time in five seasons. The Knights hit their stride late, winning six of their final seven regular-season games. Bellarmine lost a significant amount of experience from last year's squad as five seniors departed the program, including Mikayla Berry and Mallory Schwartz, who had both earned All-GLVC accolades in their respective careers, and Ally Mayhaus, who left ranked third in career blocks.

However, in senior guards Breia Torrens and Tasia Jeffries, Bellarmine's two most highly decorated players from last season are back. Torrens was a first-team All-GLVC selection while Jeffries garnered third-team acknowledgement. Torrens is set to become a four-year starter. She earned a spot on the ASUN Preseason All-Conference Team after averaging a team-best 13.2 points per game last season while amassing team highs in 3-pointers made (61) and steals (54). Her 2.3 assists per game ranked second on the team.

Jeffries followed Torrens at 10.6 points per game as she knocked down 50 3-pointers, a team-best 87.8 percent of her free throws and averaged 3.1 rebounds. Jeffries canned six 3-pointers at Rockhurst in scoring 24 points.

Bellarmine's third senior, forward Lauren Deel, was a part-time starter last season and has over 40 starts to her name. Deel averaged 6.9 points and 3.2 rebounds last season. She posted a pair of 18-point performances and had a 12-point, 10-rebound double-double at McKendree.

Junior guard Kathleen Scott made 11 starts last season and accumulated 26 starts over her first two years. Bellarmine's sizable junior class also includes guards Bailee Harney and Presley Brown, forward/center Danielle Feldkamp and forward Sheniqua Coatney, a Louisiana-Monroe transfer.

Bellarmine's lone sophomore is guard Ashlee Harris, who saw action in all 29 games last season. Harris scored in double figures in two of the team's final three regular-season games last year. In addition to Coatney, Bellarmine's newcomers include four true freshmen. They are guards Hannah Farrell, Claire Knies and Lydia Reimbold and forward Lucy Robertson.



THERE AND BACK AGAIN: When Chancellor Dugan came to Bellarmine in 2012, her arrival signaled a return to Division II for the Knights' coach. Now, she's returned to Division I without ever having left the program. Further adding to the "full circle" effect, Dugan has re-entered the ASUN Conference after previously being the head coach of former league member Florida Atlantic for 13 seasons, a program she guided to the 2005-06 ASUN championship and subsequent appearance in the NCAA Tournament. Prior to Bellarmine and Florida Atlantic, Dugan was the head coach for eight seasons at DII Southern Indiana, which was a member of Bellarmine's former league, the Great Lakes Valley Conference. She led the Screaming Eagles to an appearance in the NCAA II national title game in 1997.

AND THE NOMINATION GOES TO ... BREIA TORRENS: Breia Torrens was nominated as both ASUN Preseason Player of the Year and ASUN Preseason Defensive Player of the Year. In addition, the senior guard was among 10 selected for the ASUN's Preseason All-Conference Team. Torrens was a first-team All-GLVC selection last season after leading Bellarmine in scoring (13.2), field goals made (128), 3-pointers made (61), 3-point percentage (37.4) and minutes played (27.4) while ranking second in assists (2.3). Defensively, she topped the Knights in steals (54) and ranked ninth in the GLVC. She delivered a 34-point game against McKendree and a 29-point outburst against top-ranked Drury. Torrens piled up six steals against Trevecca Nazarene and tallied three or more thefts in seven games.

B(B)FF - BEST (BASKETBALL) FRIENDS FOREVER: Senior guards Breia Torrens and Tasia Jeffries share a deep friendship off the court, and a deep kinship on it as well. When Jeffries transferred to Bellarmine last season from St. Louis University, she reunited with Torrens after the two played together in high school at Butler Traditional in Louisville. The duo helped lead the Bears to state championships their freshman and junior seasons. Last season, the then-juniors were both All-GLVC selections, with Torrens earning first-team accolades and Jeffries garnering third-team acknowledgement. Heading into this season, Torrens and Jeffries were appointed as team captains.

CITY GIRLS: Bellarmine boasts five players who are from Louisville. Senior guards Breia Torrens and Tasia Jeffries, senior forward Lauren Deel, junior forward/center Danielle Feldkamp and sophomore guard Ashlee Harris are all Louisville products. Torrens and Jeffries both attended Butler Traditional, Feldkamp went to Mercy, Harris attended Sacred Heart Academy and Deel went to North Bullitt.

BOOKS AND BASKETBALL: Bellarmine players have thrived in the classroom over Coach Chancellor Dugan's eight-year tenure. In seven of those years, the Knights earned the Team Academic All-GLVC Award, which honors programs that achieve a minimum 3.30 GPA for an academic year. Bellarmine's top effort in that span was a 3.63 team GPA in 2018-19. In 2015-16, 12 Knights garnered Academic All-GLVC accolades. Returning players who received Academic All-GLVC notice in 2019-20 include Danielle Feldkamp, Kathleen Scott and Breia Torrens. Since 2013, 14 Knights received the GLVC Council of Presidents Academic Excellence Award, which recognizes players who completed their eligibility with a minimum 3.5 GPA. In 2018-19, Liza Tibbs earned the GLVC Brother James Gaffney Distinguished Scholar Award for posting a 4.0 GPA for the academic year.

FAB FIVE: In late September, Bellarmine announced its All-Decade Team for the 2010s. Breia Torrens, a current senior guard and ASUN Preseason All-Conference Team selection, was among the five members of the group, which also included guards Kylie Brady (2008-13), Mackenzie Martinez (2013-16) and Raven Merriweather (2014-18) and forward Sarah Galvin (2012-17), who was voted Player of the Decade in an online poll. Brady, Merriweather and Galvin were each three-time All-GLVC recipients; Galvin was also a 2017 All-American and two-time All-Midwest Region performer. Martinez, who excelled as a passer and perimeter defender, was a GLVC All-Defensive Team honoree.

KENTUCKIANA: There are 12 members of the Knights who are products of either Kentucky or Indiana. Eight of the Knights hail from the Bluegrass State. They include Bailee Harney of Covington, Presley Brown of Hodgenville, Kathleen Scott of Mt. Washington and Breia Torrens, Tasia Jeffries, Ashlee Harris, Lauren Deel and Danielle Feldkamp of Louisville. Bellarmine boasts four players from the Hoosier State in Hannah Farrell of Greenfield, Lucy Robertson of Crandall, Claire Knies of Jasper and Lydia Reimbold of Fort Wayne. Bellarmine does have one player on its roster who is not from Kentucky or Indiana in Sheniqua Coatney, who is a product of Shreveport, Louisiana. The junior forward is a transfer from Louisiana-Monroe.

NEW ASSISTANTS WHO WERE STARS: Crystal Kelly, who rejoined Bellarmine's coaching staff this season, and Abby Owings, who is brand new to the Knights' staff, were both heavily decorated college players. Kelly was a three-time All-American at Western Kentucky University who had her No. 42 retired. Heading into this season, she remained WKU's all-time leader in points (2,803), scoring average (21.6), rebounds (1,258), field goals made (953), field-goal percentage (61.7) and free throws made (885). Owings was a three-time All-American at DIII Thomas More University and was named to the D3hoops.com All-Decade Team. Going into this season, Owings ranked second on Thomas More's career scoring list (1,789 points), third in assists (434) and first in 3-pointers made (264).

SWEET 16: Before entering Division I, Bellarmine made 16 appearances in the NCAA II Tournament, starting with a 1986 campaign that concluded in the Elite Eight. That was the first of four Elite Eight showings for the Knights, who also advanced to the national quarterfinals in 1990, 1991 and 1994. The latter squad earned a berth in the Final Four. and was inducted into the Bellarmine Athletic Hall of Fame in 2009. The Knights earned two NCAA II Tournament bids under Coach Chancellor Dugan, making back-to-back appearances in "The Big Dance" in 2016 and 2017. In the former season, Bellarmine posted a 24-4 record, tying the best win percentage (.857) in program history.

CONFERENCE CONTENDERS: Bellarmine earned a berth in the GLVC Tournament in all 23 years of the event's existence. The Knights hoisted the championship trophy in 2016 after defeating Saint Joseph's (IN) 59-52, No. 10 Drury 80-77 and No. 22 Quincy 89-78. BU also advanced to the title game in 2019. In their last five years in the league, the Knights advanced to at least the semifinals on four occasions. In their final go-around, they knocked off their archrival, Southern Indiana, 66-59 in the opening round. Before the GLVC Tournament was launched in 1998, BU won league titles in 1983, 1994 and 1996 and was co-champion in 1986. From 1984 through 1997, the Knights never placed lower than fourth in the GLVC, including seven runner-up finishes in addition to the title years.

SCORE ONE FOR '94: In a preseason series naming the top seasons in ASUN-sponsored sports histories for member institutions, Bellarmine's new league selected its 1993-94 campaign as its best ever. The Knights advanced to the Final Four of the NCAA II Tournament and finished 25-6 while capturing the GLVC title. It was the first Knights team of any sport inducted into the Bellarmine Athletic Hall of Fame. That honor was bestowed upon the 1993-94 squad in 2009. The 1982 men's cross country team, which placed seventh at the NCAA II Championships, followed by being inducted in 2011, while the 2010-11 men's basketball team, which captured the NCAA II national title, was inducted in 2017.

SEVEN HEAVEN: Seven players earned Division II All-America accolades in Bellarmine's history, including at least one over the previous four decades. The most recent came in 2017 compliments of forward Sarah Galvin. That acknowledgement came a little over three decades after the first All-America recognition was awarded in 1986 to guard Roxanne Cox, who repeated in 1987. That same year, forward Stephanie Tracy began the first of her three straight All-America campaigns. Bellarmine added three more in the '90s. Forward Sharonda O'Bannon was cited in 1991, guard Jenny O'Bryan in 1994 and center Molly Niehaus in 1997. Guard Nickie Randall was a 2000s representative for Bellarmine, landing All-America laurels in 2003.

GREAT EIGHT: In the 2000s, Bellarmine was ranked in the top 25 of the WBCA's Division II poll in eight different seasons. Most recently, the Knights were ranked nationally for the vast majority of the 2016-17 campaign. They spent eight weeks in the top 10 and 10 in the top 15. Bellarmine was ranked as high as No. 4 for four consecutive weeks, which stands as the Knights' highest ranking of the 2000s. They climbed to No. 9 in 2002-03 and No. 11 in 2003-04.

UPPER TIER: Bellarmine has had six head coaches in a history that dates back to 1971. Its current leader, Chancellor Dugan, who's in her ninth season, is in the upper echelon of the collection of coaches in all-time wins at Bellarmine. Dugan entered this season with 143 career victories, which ranks third in program history. Charlie Just, who coached the Knights for 14 seasons (1984-98), is the program's all-time leader in wins with 299, while Dave Smith, who also coached Bellarmine for 14 seasons (1998-12), is second with 247 career victories. Dugan registered her 50th win at Bellarmine in a 72-58 triumph over Illinois Springfield on Dec. 3 of 2015. Her 100th career victory with the Knights came in a 93-65 romp over Wisconsin Parkside on Jan. 13 of 2018.

**HEAD COACH CHANCELLOR DUGAN**

On June 22, 2012, Chancellor Dugan became the sixth head coach in Bellarmine University women's basketball history.



Dugan will enter her ninth season in 2020-21.

In eight years at Bellarmine in Division II before the program transitioned to Division I and the ASUN Conference, Dugan built a record of 143-85 overall and 87-59 in the Great Lakes Valley Conference. She guided the Knights to their first-ever GLVC Tournament title in 2016, along with appearing in the conference tourney in all eight seasons.

Sara Galvin was an All-American in the 2016-17 campaign while Raven Merriweather earned GLVC co-Freshman of the Year honors in 2014-15. The Knights amassed 15 All-GLVC awards in Dugan's time with them in DII.

Bellarmine went 18-11 in 2019-20, its final season in DII. The Knights defeated archrival Southern Indiana 66-59 in the GLVC Tournament quarterfinals, marking the fourth time in five years the team captured at least one conference tourney victory.

In 2018-19, Bellarmine advanced to the GLVC Tournament finals for the second time under Dugan, notably defeating No. 15 Lewis 78-77 in the semifinals. The Knights earned a berth in the tournament after a late-season surge in which they won five of six games during a stretch just prior to the postseason.

Despite a slew of injuries and an underclassmen-heavy rotation, Dugan led Bellarmine to a 16-12 overall record and 11-7 GLVC mark in 2017-18, including an 84-70 victory over No. 6 Drury that marked the Panthers' lone league loss. The Knights earned their customary bid to the GLVC Tournament.

In 2016-17, Dugan guided Bellarmine to a berth in the NCAA Tournament for the second season in a row. At 22-8, the Knights completed their first back-to-back 20-win season in a dozen years. The Knights tied for second in

the GLVC East and earned a first-round bye in the GLVC Tournament. Bellarmine was nationally ranked for the vast majority of the season, and Galvin earned All-America honors.

In 2015-16, Dugan's squad returned to the prominence not witnessed in the program since the 1990s, tying the program record for best win percentage in a season (85.7) after finishing 24-4. The Knights' 15-3 mark in the GLVC tied its best output among its 18-game conference seasons. Dugan guided Bellarmine to an unprecedented GLVC Tournament championship after her squad upset No. 10 Drury, 80-77, in the semifinals and claimed the title with an 89-78 victory over No. 22 Quincy in the finals. That set the stage for a Selection Sunday in which it was announced that Bellarmine earned its first NCAA Tournament berth since 2008. The Knights entered the Big Dance ranked 20th in the nation.

Dugan made an immediate impact on the team in her first season. Inheriting a program coming off two losing seasons, she turned the Knights around in 2012-13 and led the team to a 19-11 record that included a 10-1 start to her tenure.

Dugan, a Sacred Heart Academy graduate, spent 13 seasons as head coach at Florida Atlantic University before taking the helm at Bellarmine. At FAU, she led the Owls to their respective conference postseason tournament each year. In 2005-06, FAU captured the Atlantic Sun championship and earned the conference's automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament.

Prior to her stint at FAU, Dugan was head coach at GLVC rival Southern Indiana, where she coached the Screaming Eagles to four NCAA Tournament appearances in eight seasons from 1991-99 including an appearance in the 1997 NCAA Division II national championship game. Dugan guided USI to

a 30-2 record in 1997 that included 29 straight wins.

In 1997-98, Dugan picked up GLVC Coach of the Year honors for the second consecutive season, leading USI to another regular-season title and capturing the inaugural GLVC Tournament at Roberts Stadium in Evansville, Indiana.

Dugan's players have accumulated a combined four conference Player of the Year, one Defensive Player of the Year and two Freshman of the Year awards (GLVC, TAAC/Atlantic Sun, Sun Belt).

A four-year letter winner for Eastern Kentucky University (1978-82), Dugan was a three-year starter and finished her junior and senior seasons as the Lady Colonels' leading rebounder and second-leading scorer. She earned a bachelor of science in physical education from ECU and a master of arts in physical education from Morehead State University.
