Northern Kentucky Points

• NKU is out to its best-ever start in Horizon League play at 4-0 thanks to a pair of 83-48 and 80-63 wins on December 19 and 20, respectively.

• The Norse are defeating their opponents by an average margin of 23 points in conference action through four games.

 Through eight games this season, NKU is outrebounding its opponents by 12.3 boards per game (42.3-30.0 rpg). That margin ranks 22nd-best in the nation.

NKU's regularly-scheduled bouts with Cleveland State have been cancelled due to COVIDrelated matters within the Vikings' program. The Norse will now face No. 2 Louisville on the road on Saturday.

 NKU is an even 12-12 all-time against Louisville, with the last meeting being a 85-57 victory for the Cardinals in BB&T Arena on December 8, 2019.

• NKU is coming off of its first 20-win season during the DI era. The Norse went 6-5 in the nonconference before posting a 12-6 mark in League play and going 2-1 in the Horizon League

Championship.

• NKU steamrolled both Detroit Mercy and Milwaukee in the opening two rounds of the Horizon League Championship. The Norse held two leads in the final minute, but ultimately fell short of Green Bay by one point in the semifinals.

• The Norse return quite a bit of experience, losing only three players from last year's squad. NKU welcomes back approximately 76 percent of its minutes played and 73 percent of its scor-

• The Norse were picked to finish fourth in the Horizon League Preseason Coaches Poll.

 Junior guard Lindsey Duvall has been active and impactful early in her Norse tenure. She registered her first-three double-doubles in consecutive fashion against Bowling Green (10 points, career-high 14 rebounds), No. 19 Ohio State (12 points, 10 rebounds) and Robert Morris (21 points, 10 rebounds). She is leading the Norse in points (14.5) and rebounds (8.1) per game.

• Sophomore guard **Ivy Turner** was in the starting rotation every game last year. Turner contributed 8.3 ppg for NKU and was second on the team with 66 dimes. She is scoring at an even better 10.0 ppg clip this year.

• Junior guard Ally Niece, who is coming off a sophomore campaign in which she was named to both the all-tournament and all-league second teams, earned a spot on the All-Horizon League

Preseason First Team. She is averaging 7.8 ppg in the young 2020-21 season.

• Senior forward **Kailey Coffey** has played in 100 games with 99 starts (tied for 13th all-time) during a Norse career in which she has moved into 11th all-time at NKU with 727 rebounds.

• Junior forward **Emmy Souder** started all 32 games as a sophomore. She was third on the team in scoring at 8.8 ppg and second in rebounding at 5.4 rpg. She is averaging 4.0 points and 4.8 rebounds per game so far this year.

• Sophomore guard Carissa Garcia averaged 7.3 ppg as a freshman and continues to make an

impact with 7.8 scores a contest.

• Five newcomers join the squad this season, including Louisville transfer junior guard Duvall as well as freshmen guard Kennedy Igo, center Emma Palmer, center Christyan Reid and guard/ wing Ellie Taylor.

LAST TIME OUT: PURDUE FORT WAYNE

Another weekend-sweep was the name of the game for NKU on December 19 and 20 at Purdue Fort Wayne.

On Saturday, the Norse put together their most complete game of the young season, routing the Mastodons, 83-48. Four Norse reached the double-figures threshold in the win: Lindsey Duvall (18), Carissa Garcia (16) Kailey Coffey (14), and freshman Kennedy Igo (12). Coffey also registered 10 rebounds in the matchup for her sixth-career double-double, and her first since having 14 points and 11 rebounds against Wright State on Jan. 12, 2019.

Although the Mastodons had more fight in them on Sunday, the Norse still pulled away by game's end to an 80-63 victory, thanks to exceptional shooting (31-for-55, 56 percent). **Grayson Rose** and **Lindsey Duvall** led the Norse with 23 and 20 points, respectively in the contest. The win marked the first-time NKU reached the 80-point mark in back-to-back games since Feb. 18 and 21, 2016, when it respectively poured in 81 against Detroit Mercy and 80 versus Oakland.

SCOUTING: NO. 2 LOUISVILLE

An impressive start to the 2020-21 season for the Cardinals has merited them a No. 2 ranking, as well as a first-place vote in the Associated Press Top-25 poll. Louisville is currently a perfect 5-0 on the young year with a notable 116-75 win over No. 18 DePaul.

Louisville boasts four different players that are averaging double-figures in each contest: Dana Evans (21.0), Hailey Van Lith (15.6), Kianna Smith (15.3), Olivia Cochran (13.8). Evans, an AP Preseason All-American, is the primary disher for the Cardinals, generating 4.6 assists a contest, while Cochran, a freshman forward, leads the team in rebounds with 9.0 a game.

SERIES STUFF

NKU is 12-12 against Cleveland State all-time. The Norse lost to the Cardinals, 85-57, in their last matchup on December 8, 2019 in BB&T Arena.

20-WIN PLATEAU

While Northern Kentucky had come close in two of its first seven seasons as a Division I program, the 2019-20 Norse were the first to notch a 20-win campaign in the era. The 2014-15 and 2015-16 teams each won 19 games. NKU got off to a slow start with a 1-4 mark, although two games were one-possession contests late. However, it responded with 4-straight wins, a winning streak that it matched on two other occasions, before finishing the nonconference at 6-5. The Norse continued their strong play throughout the Horizon League slate, going 12-6 with wins against IUPUI and Green Bay teams that finished 1-2 in the League standings. NKU finished fourth, one game behind Wright State. As the No. 4 seed in the League tournament, NKU hosted a pair of games against Detroit Mercy and Milwaukee, both of which it won easily to advance to the semifinals versus Green Bay.

PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATIONS

Northern Kentucky was picked to finish fourth in the preseason poll, garnering 105 points. IUPUI was picked first, earning all 12 first-place votes, followed by Green Bay and Wright State as the first four teams mirror last season's final standings. Although it is still early in the league slate, the Norse are one of three teams still undefeated in league play.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

The Norse had an eight-game home winning streak snapped by Bowling Green. However, over the last two years, they have begun to turn BB&T Arena into a wrecking ball for opposing teams, amassing a 22-9 overall record at home after going 12-4 last year, 8-4 in 2018-19, and 2-1 on the young season.

BATTLE OF THE BOARDS

Northern Kentucky has been absolutely ferocious on the glass to start the season, outrebounding foes by 12.3 rebounds per game, 42.3-30.0, which equates to the 22nd-best margin in the nation. NKU is just as relentless on the offensive end as it is on the defensive side, pulling down 14.0 offensive caroms per game. **Lindsey Duvall** leads the way with at 8.1 rpg, but four other Norse are also averaging at least 3.8 rpg., **Kailey Coffey** (7.3), **Grayson Rose** (4.9) **Emmy Souder** (4.8), and **Ivy Turner** (3.8)

VETERAN PRESENCE

Northern Kentucky returns quite a bit of experience from last season, including four starters in Ally Niece, Ivy Turner, Emmy Souder and Kailey Coffey. Slightly over 75 percent (75.7) of the team's minutes return, as well as 72.9 percent of its scoring production. Niece leads the pack after averaging 13.1 points per game last year and is joined by both Turner and Souder who contributed 8.8 and 8.3 ppg as the team's second and third-leading scorer's, respectively.

The team's three leading rebounders in Coffey, Souder and **Grayson Rose** return, as do the top three table-setters in Niece, Turner and Coffey.

Coffey has now played in 100 games for NKU, earning starts in all but one game of her Norse career.

NEW NORSE

Northern Kentucky welcomed five new faces to the fold this year, including junior guard Lindsay Duvall, who transferred from Louisville during the offseason. Freshmen Kennedy Igo, Emma Palmer, Ellie Taylor and Christyan Reid also joined the team. Duvall and Taylor and length and athleticism to the guard and wing positions. Igo brings court awareness to her point guard role. While Palmer adds much needed size to the post and fellow front court player Reid adds both height and length. All four of NKU's freshmen this season have seen time and scored points.

NONCONFERENCE SLATE

Northern Kentucky had just four games on the nonconference slate. It dropped the Nov. 25 season-opener at Cincinnati, 73-67, in overtime as well as the Dec. 1 matchup at Akron (70-60). The lone home game came versus Bowling Green (L, 49-63). The Norse concluded their nonconference with a trip to No. 19 Ohio State, falling 96-63.

NIECE'S NORSE

Junior point guard **Ally Niece** had quite a sophomore campaign. She followed an all-freshman team outing with a sophomore season that featured nods on the Horizon League All-Tournament and All-Horizon League Second Teams.

Niece finished the season on a tear, pouring in four 20-point performances

in the team's last six games. She averaged 13.1 points and 3.7 assists per game in leading NKU to its first 20-win season during the DI era.

She opened the 2020-21 slate with a 17-point showing at Cincinnati and is averaging 7.8 ppg this year.

COFFEY ON THE GLASS

Kailey Coffey has been a steady presence for the Norse. In her senior season, she has already played in 100 games and earned 99 starts. Though just 5-foot-10, Coffey is a presence on the glass. She has 727 career boards, which ranks 11th in Northern Kentucky's record books. Coffey's six rebounds against Purdue Fort Wayne on Dec. 20 pushed her past Cindy Schlarman (725). With 715 career-points, she is also on pace to push into NKU's top-50 career scoring list.

TURNER TURNS IT ON

Ivy Turner wasted little time making an impact in Highland Heights. The diminutive guard was thrust into the starting lineup from the onset and seized the opportunity, starting all 32 games as a freshman. She was third on the team in scoring last season at 8.8 points per game. Turner also dished out 66 assists and swiped 43 steals.

So far in 2020-21, she is averaging a solid 10.0 ppg to go along with 3.8 rebounds and 2.3 assists.

SOUDER KEEPS BUILDING

Emmy Souder continued NKU's string of players improving from her first to second year on campus in Highland Heights. The 6-foot-1 forward improved in nearly every statistical category. She went from 5.8 points per game to 8.3, while increasing her shooting efficiency in both total field-goal percent and 3-point field goal percent. Souder was more active on the boards, improving her rebound totals by 2.0 per game to 5.4 rpg. Despite playing over seven more minutes per game, Souder also cut down on turnovers (49-42) and drastically increased her steals total (5-28).

Souder opened her 2020-21 campaign with a 10-point, seven-rebound effort against Cincinnati.

DUVALL'S DEBUT

Lindsey Duvall made her Norse debut in fine fashion against Cincinnati, scor-

ing 13 points behind efficient 4-of-6 shooting from the floor and 5-of-6 at the charity stripe. She added a pair of rebounds to the stat sheet as well. The Louisville transfer was playing in her first game at Northern Kentucky and saw 18 minutes of action. She followed up with a 10-point, career-high seven-rebound effort at Akron.

Duvall became the first Norse since 2008 to post three-consecutive doubles on December 3-12 (10 points, 14 rebounds vs. Bowling Green on Dec. 3; 12 points, 10 rebounds at No. 19 Ohio State on Dec. 6, 21 points, 10 rebounds vs. Robert Morris on Dec. 12). The last Norse to have three-straight doubledoubles was when Angela Healy had 4 from Jan. 10-19, 2008.

Duvall is currently leading the team in scoring at 14.5 points and 8.1 rebounds per game.

EVERYONE'S DISHIN'

It's been a balanced effort for the Norse in making the extra pass. Ivy Turner, Carissa Garcia and Ally Niece each have 18 assists on the season, while Kailey Coffey isn't far behind with 17. NKU's four players with 15 or more assists is the most in the Horizon League.

In her first season, the Norse went 9-22, including 5-11 in the Horizon League. The Norse were third in the Horizon League in sccoring defense, holding opponents to 63.8 points per game. Following the regular season, senior Rebecca Lyttle was named to the All-Horizon League Defensive Team for her relentless effort under the basket.

NKU posted a 9-22 record in 2017-18 as well, but the team showed marked improvement that was highlighted by possibly the biggest upset in women's college basketball that year when the Norse upended No. 19/20 Green Bay on Dec. 30. Kailey Coffey earned all-freshman team honors after leading the Norse in rebounds and ranking second on the team in scoring.

The Norse recorded the highest conference finish since moving to the Horizon League in the 2018-19 campaign, going 10-8 to finish fifth in the Horizon League. Ally Niece was named to the Horizon League All-Freshman Team and NKU finished the year with an 11-18 mark.

NKU continued to improve under Whitaker's fourth year at the helm, recording the first 20-win season of the Division I era and advancing to the semifinals of the Horizon League Championship. Niece and Molly Glick were both named to the All-Horizon League Second Team and Ivy Turner earned all-freshman distinction. Niece also claimed all-tournament honors.

Whitaker joined the Norse after spending one season at Kentucky, helping the Wildcats to a 25-8 overall record and the team's seventh consecutive trip to the NCAA Tournament, resulting in a Sweet Sixteen appearance in 2016.

Whitaker spent the previous three seasons at Dayton, where she was primarily responsible for the guards and recruiting. During her tenure, the Flyers amassed 78 wins to just 17 losses, claiming the Atlantic 10 regular-season championship in 2013 and 2014 and advancing to the program's first-ever Elite Eight appearance in 2015.

A native of Cynthiana, Kentucky, Whitaker played her prep ball at Harrison County High School, where she garnered

USA Today honorable mention and second-team All-Kentucky honors.

Following high school, Whitaker played five seasons at Western Kentucky University, leading the Hilltoppers to 97 wins and postseason berths in each of her seasons. Whitaker helped the team to the 2003 Sun Belt Conference Tournament championship and an NCAA Tournament bid, and stands third on WKU's all-time assist chart. Whitaker returned to her alma mater for the 2011-12 season as an assistant coach.

Whitaker started her coaching career in 2006 at Austin Peay, where she spent two seasons before joining the staff at Missouri State in 2009. She helped guide the Lady Bears to a pair of WNIT appearances, including a third-round trip in 2010. Missouri State amassed 46 wins over her two seasons in Springfield.
