WARM-UPS

The Bellarmine women's basketball team will face crosstown foe Louisville at 7 p.m. (ET) Tuesday at the KFC Yum! Center.

The contest marks the second of the season for Bellarmine, which opened its 2021-22 campaign Friday with a 72-59 loss at Cincinnati. The clash against the Cardinals represents the second of four straight road contests to start the season for the Knights.

Louisville leads the all-time series against Bellarmine 15-4. They met 18 times before the Knights made the transition to Division I and then last season when BU made its D1 debut. The Cardinals captured the 2020-21 contest 97-46 at home.

The last time Bellarmine beat Louisville came in the 1983-84 season, when the Knights secured a 76-67 road win. That victory marked the second straight triumph for Bellarmine over the Cardinals. U of L had built an eight-game winning streak prior to those matchups.

KNIGHT INSIGHTS

- Bellarmine returns 10 players from last season's team, including three starters in forwards Lauren Deel and Sheniqua Coatney and guard Kathleen Scott.
- Claire Knies scored a career-high 21 points in Bellarmine's season opener against Cincinnati.
 The sophomore guard also posted career bests in field goals made (8) and 3-pointers made (5).
- Knies actually topped her previous career high of nine points in the first quarter alone against the Bearcats. She racked up 10 in the period behind a pair of 3-pointers.
- Deel is the first Bellarmine player to utilize her "COVID year." The fifth-year forward flirted with a double-double against Cincinnati after collecting 10 points and 8 rebounds. Deel has amassed 108 games played in her career.
- Guards Jaela Johnson and Mackenzie Keelin are both transfers who made their Bellarmine debuts against Cincinnati. Johnson started and contributed 6 points, 6 rebounds and 2 steals in 30 minutes. Keelin tallied 5 points in 11 minutes. Freshman Anzley Adwell made her collegiate debut against the Bearcats.

LAST GAME: Hailey Van Lith led the way with 19 points, but No. 6 Louisville fell 61-59 in overtime to No. 15 Arizona on Friday at the Sanford Pentagon in Sioux Falls, S.D. in its season opener. The contest was close throughout and featured nine lead changes and 11 ties. The fourth quarter featured six lead changes and nine ties itself. Van Lith knocked down two free throws with 13 seconds to play to tie it at 54-54. Bendu Yeaney put Arizona ahead midway through overtime with her only 3-pointer of the game. After Louisville tied it with a free throw, Yeaney sank a jumper with 1:45 left and neither team scored again.

BELLARMINE ATHLETICS ENTERS 2ND SEASON IN D1

The 2021-22 season marks Bellarmine University's second as a full-scale Division I athletics program.

Bellarmine celebrated the elevation of its athletics program from NCAA Division II to NCAA Division I on July 1, 2020. The jump made Bellarmine the only private D1 university in Kentucky and one of only a handful of D1 Catholic universities in the South.

All 22 of the Knights' varsity sports programs now compete in D1, including 18 in the ASUN Conference. Previously, only lacrosse competed at the NCAA's highest level.

Bellarmine's move to D1 was announced in the summer of 2019 as one of the first major initiatives in the university's strategic plan.





HOME COURT/FREEDOM HALL

The 2021-22 campaign marks the second season in which the Bellarmine University women's and men's basketball teams will be competing in venerable Freedom Hall.

A multiyear partnership between Bellarmine and Kentucky Venues was announced in early November of 2020. The Knights squads now call Freedom Hall — one of college basketball's most storied venues — their home.

With the COVID-19 pandemic limiting seating capacity for the 2020-21 season, Bellarmine began looking for alternate venues for its home basketball games.

Bellarmine Director of Athletics Scott Wiegandt said at the time that "Freedom Hall was a natural choice as it's steeped in rich basketball tradition and is minutes from our campus."

"We then saw the obvious benefits of making Freedom Hall a more long-term home for our basketball programs," Wiegandt said. "It has long been considered one of the best places in the world to watch a basketball game and the venue gives us ample room to grow into our new D-I status."

Freedom Hall is a 18,252-seat arena. By comparison, Knights Hall, the previous home of the Bellarmine basketball teams, seats 2,196.

The basketball floor mirrors the one in Knights Hall, which remains in use as the home of Bellarmine volleyball and wrestling and as a practice space. Bellarmine also added branding throughout Freedom Hall that ensures players and fans feel at home.

Located in the Kentucky Exposition Center and operated by the Kentucky Venues, Freedom Hall completed numerous upgrades recently that enhance the fan experience, including new lighting in the concourse and arena, renovated suites, state-of-the-art display on the center-hung digital scoreboard and a cutting-edge sound system.

Freedom Hall, which opened in 1956, was the home of the University of Louisville Cardinals for more than five decades, and it has hosted the Final Four six times.

The arena also was home to the Kentucky Colonels of the American Basketball Association and was the site of Louisville legend Muhammad Ali's first professional boxing match in 1960.

2021-22 OUTLOOK: After getting its feet wet, the 2021-22 campaign marks the Bellarmine University women's basketball team's second in Division I.

In its inaugural season in D1, Bellarmine posted a 5-17 record.

The Knights, under Head Coach Chancellor Dugan, hit their peak during their first ASUN Conference slate, amassing a four-game winning streak that included a two-game sweep of Kennesaw State and wins over Stetson and Jacksonville.

Bellarmine returns a significant portion of the team, including three incumbent starters in senior forwards Lauren Deel and Sheniqua Coatney and senior guard Kathleen Scott.

Deel is back for a fifth season. The frontcourt veteran has appeared in over 100 games in her career and started for most of the previous three seasons. Deel was second on Bellarmine last season in rebounding (4.0) and third in scoring (9.0). She delivered a 22-point game against Stetson last season. Deel won the league's Facebook fan vote for ASUN Preseason Player of the Year.

Coatney was an impact transfer for Bellarmine last season. She led the team in rebounding (5.7) and field-goal percentage (47.4) and ranked fourth in scoring (8.3). The 27 points she poured in against Jacksonville and the 12 rebounds she hauled in against Liberty were both Bellarmine individual highs on the season.

Scott logged over 40 starts in her first three seasons. She led the team in assists (2.5) last year and was third in rebounding (3.5) while averaging 5.6 points and ranking fifth in the conference in free-throw percentage (79.3). Scott earned the majority Facebook fan vote for ASUN Preseason Defensive Player of the Year.

Senior guard Presley Brown has appeared in 65 games in her career and ranked fourth on the team in rebounding (3.2) and fifth in scoring (6.3) last season. She registered consecutive 14-point games against North Alabama last year.

Junior guard Ashlee Harris and senior guard Bailee Harney averaged 22.0 and 13.7 minutes, respectively, last season. Sophomore guards Hannah Farrell and Claire Knies appeared in 21 games apiece in their debut seasons while sophomore guard Lydia Reimbold and sophomore forward Lucy Robertson both averaged over nine minutes per game in their first years.

Jaela Johnson brings experience to the backcourt as the redshirt junior spent three seasons and appeared in 44 games at Toledo before transferring to Bellarmine.

Redshirt sophomore guard Mackenzie Keelin does as well after playing her freshman season at Tennessee Tech before joining the Knights.

Bellarmine has three true freshmen in guards Bralee Trice and Anzley Adwell and forward Haley Stoklosa



SEASON OF FIRSTS

The 2020-21 campaign marked Bellarmine's first in Division I. The Knights' first-ever D1 victory came on Jan. 24, 2021, in DeLand, Florida when they defeated Stetson 71-64. That triumph also represented Bellarmine's first-ever ASUN win. The Knights followed with a 73-67 victory over Kennesaw State in Freedom Hall, which began their first D1 winning streak, a stretch that ultimately lasted four games. Bellarmine concluded the season with its inaugural appearance in the ASUN Tournament. The Knights earned the 7-seed in the postseason event.

GOOD DEEL

Lauren Deel is the first Bellarmine player to take advantage of the fifth season granted by the NCAA due to the pandemic. The 2020-21 season, which was greatly affected by COVID-19 across the country, did not count against player eligibility. Deel is back for Round 5 in a Bellarmine uniform after having already appeared in 107 career games with 63 starts. The 5-foot-11 forward enters the season with 764 points and 367 rebounds in her career. Deel posted career highs in scoring (9.2) and rebounding (4.1) last season while shooting 46.6 percent from the field.

SHINE AT THE LINE

Bellarmine led the ASUN in free-throw percentage in 2020-21. The Knights topped the league after shooting 73.6 percent from the charity stripe. That tally was nearly 2 percent higher than FGCU, which shot 71.8 percent from the line. Bellarmine boasted a 15-for-16 outing (93.8) in a Jan. 17 home game against FGCU and went 15-for-17 (88.2) on the road Feb. 7 against Jacksonville. The most free throws the Knights made last season came in their first-ever D1 win when they sank 27 in 35 attempts Jan. 24 at Stetson. Individually, Breia Torrens led the ASUN after shooting 87.2 percent from the charity stripe while Kathleen Scott ranked fifth at 79.3 percent.

BIG SHOES TO FILL

Bellarmine lost its two most decorated players from last season to graduation in the backcourt duo of Tasia Jeffries and Breia Torrens. Jeffries was Bellarmine's Ione ASUN All-Conference recipient, earning second-team accolades after leading Bellarmine in scoring (13.8), 3-pointers made (47), steals (35) and minutes played (33.5) while ranking third on team in assists (1.6) and tying for fourth in rebounds (3.2). Torrens was named to the ASUN Preseason All-Conference Team. She led the team in free-throw percentage (87.2) and ranked second in scoring (10.6), 3-pointers made (28), assists (2.3) and minutes (28.6). Both Jeffries and Torrens, who were also high school teammates, earned spots on the ASUN All-Academic Team, an honor that recognizes both academic and athletic achievement.

MAKING A MARK

Sheniqua Coatney transferred to Bellarmine last season after spending her first two college seasons at Louisiana-Monroe and made an immediate impact on the Knights. The 6-foot-2 forward led the team in rebounding (5.7) and field-goal percentage (47.4) while ranking second in blocks (11) and fourth in scoring (8.3). Her 27 points and 11 field goals made against Jacksonville on Feb. 7 and her 12 rebounds against Liberty on Feb. 14 were all Bellarmine individual highs for the season.

LOOKING IN LOUISVILLE

Aforementioned graduates Tasia Jeffries and Breia Torrens were both natives of Louisville. Another local product, Jaela Johnson, is among the players looking to fill the hole left by the standout backcourt duo. Johnson has ample D1 experience. After attending Manual High School in Louisville, she spent her first three college seasons at Toledo and appeared in 44 games over two seasons while redshirting one year.

SOMETHING TO RAVE ABOUT

Raven Merriweather has returned to the Bellarmine bench, only now it's in an assistant-coaching capacity. A Louisville native, Merriweather played for Bellarmine from 2014-18 and left the program as the ninth-leading scorer in program history after amassing 1,420 points. The former guard earned three All-GLVC accolades when Bellarmine was a D2 program and was the 2014-15 GLVC co-Freshman of the Year while being recognized on the program's All-Decade Team. As a senior in 2017-18, Merriweather averaged 17.8 points, 6.6 rebounds and 2.2 assists while her 499 total points ranked eighth all-time for a single season in program history. Merriweather was a graduate assistant on Eastern Kentucky's staff for a year before returning to BU.

FIRST OF HER KIND

Lexxus Graham was hired as Bellarmine's first-ever Director of Basketball Operations prior to this season. Before arriving at Bellarmine, Graham spent one season as an assistant coach at Georgetown College (Ky.). The native of Winchester, Kentucky is not far removed from her playing days, suiting up for Campbellsville University (Ky.) from 2014-18. Graham was a cornerstone player for the Tigers, starting as a sophomore and senior while competing in 133 games in her collegiate career. The Tigers went 117-25 overall in her career.

KENTUCKIANA INDEED

"Kentuckiana" is a term primarily used to refer to the Louisville metro area and surrounding counties in Indiana, but it could also be used as a fairly accurate descriptor of Bellarmine's roster. Of the Knights' 15 players, 12 hail from either Kentucky or Indiana. Eight have hometowns in the Bluegrass State, while four come from cities in the Hoosier State. Representing Kentucky are Bailee Harney (Covington), Jaela Johnson (Louisville), Ashlee Harris (Louisville), Anzley Adwell (Glasgow), Presley Brown (Hodgenville), Kathleen Scott (Mt. Washington), Lauren Deel (Louisville) and Mackenzie Keelin (Owensboro). Representing Indiana are Hannah Farrell (Greenfield), Lucy Robertson (Crandall), Claire Knies (Jasper) and Lydia Reimbold (Fort Wayne).

THERE AND BACK AGAIN

When Chancellor Dugan came to Bellarmine in 2012, her arrival signaled a return to D2 for the Knights' coach. Last season, she made her return to D1 without ever having left the program. Further adding to the "full circle" effect, Dugan re-entered the ASUN after previously being the head coach of former league member Florida Atlantic for 13 seasons. She guided that program to the 2005-06 ASUN championship and subsequent appearance in the NCAA Tournament. Prior to Bellarmine and Florida Atlantic, Dugan was the head coach for eight seasons at D2 Southern Indiana, which was a member of Bellarmine's former league, the Great Lakes Valley Conference. She led the Screaming Eagles to an appearance in the 1997 NCAA II national championship game.

PROUD HISTORY

Before entering D1, Bellarmine made 16 appearances in the NCAA II Tournament, starting with a 1986 campaign that concluded in the Elite Eight. That was the first of four Elite Eight showings for the Knights, who also advanced to the national quarterfinals in 1990, 1991 and 1994. The latter squad earned a berth in the Final Four. and was inducted into the Bellarmine Athletic Hall of Fame in 2009. The Knights earned two NCAA II Tournament bids under current Coach Chancellor Dugan, making back-to-back appearances in "The Big Dance" in 2016 and 2017.

BOOKS AND BASKETBALL

Bellarmine players have thrived in the classroom over Coach Chancellor Dugan's nine-year tenure. Last season, 12 of 14 Knights made the ASUN Honor Roll (minimum 3.0 GPA). In seven of the last eight years in D2, the Knights earned the Team Academic All-GLVC Award, which honors programs that achieve a minimum 3.30 GPA for an academic year. Bellarmine's top effort in that span was a 3.63 team GPA in 2018-19. In 2015-16, 12 Knights garnered Academic All-GLVC accolades. From 2013-20, 14 Knights received the GLVC Council of Presidents Academic Excellence Award, which recognizes players who complete their eligibility with a minimum 3.5 GPA. In 2018-19, Liza Tibbs earned the GLVC Brother James Gaffney Distinguished Scholar Award for posting a 4.0 GPA for the academic year. Earning ASUN Honor Roll distinction last season were: Presley Brown, Hannah Farrell, Danielle Feldkamp, Bailee Harney, Ashlee Harris, Tasia Jeffries, Mackenzie Keelin, Claire Knies, Lydia Reimbold, Lucy Robertson, Kathleen Scott and Breia Torrens.

LOOK AT THE LEAGUE

In the ASUN preseason polls, Bellarmine was picked to finish 11th in the media poll and tied for 11th in the coaches' poll. The conference expanded from nine to 12 teams this year with the additions of Central Arkansas, Eastern Kentucky and Jacksonville State. FGCU was identified by both the coaches and media as the preseason favorite. The Eagles captured both the regular season and conference tournament titles last season, going undefeated in the process against ASUN opponents as they followed a 16-0 regular-season campaign with the tourney run. North Florida was picked to finish second by the coaches, but Liberty got the runner-up nod from the media. Jacksonville State and Kennesaw State saw the largest differences between the two polls. JSU was tabbed fourth by the media and sixth by the coaches, while KSU was seventh by the coaches and 10th by the media.



HEAD COACH CHANCELLOR DUGAN

On June 22, 2012, Chancellor Dugan became the sixth head coach in Bellarmine University women's basketball history.



The 2021-22 season marks Dugan's 10th leading the Knights.

Bellarmine's first season in Division I and the ASUN Conference came in 2020-21, marking a return to both that NCAA level and that conference for Dugan, who had a long stint at Florida Atlantic University prior to her arrival with the Knights. Bellarmine's inaugural season was highlighted by a four-game winning streak in ASUN play and All-Conference accolades for Tasia Jeffries.

In eight years at Bellarmine in Division II before the program transitioned to D1, Dugan built a record of 143-85 overall and 87-59 in the Great Lakes Valley Conference. She guided the Knights to their first-ever GLVC Tournament title in 2016, along with appearing in the conference tourney in all eight seasons.

Sarah Galvin was an All-American in the 2016-17 campaign while Raven Merriweather earned GLVC co-Freshman of the Year honors in 2014-15. The Knights amassed 15 All-GLVC awards in Dugan's time with them in D2.

Bellarmine went 18-11 in 2019-20, its final season in D2. The Knights defeated archrival Southern Indiana 66-59 in the GLVC Tournament quarterfinals, marking the fourth time in five years the team captured at least one conference tourney victory.

In 2018-19, Bellarmine advanced to the GLVC Tournament finals for the second time under Dugan, notably defeating No. 15 Lewis 78-77 in the semifinals. The Knights earned a berth in the tournament after a late-season surge in which they won five of six games during a stretch just prior to the postseason.

Despite a slew of injuries and an underclassmen-heavy rotation, Dugan led Bellarmine to a 16-12 overall record and 11-7 GLVC mark in 2017-18, including an 84-70 victory over No. 6 Drury that marked the Panthers' lone league loss. The Knights earned their customary bid to the GLVC Tournament.

In 2016-17, Dugan guided Bellarmine to a berth in the NCAA II Tournament for the second season in a row. At 22-8, the Knights completed their first back-to-back 20-win season in a dozen years. The Knights tied for second in the GLVC East and earned a first-round bye in the GLVC Tournament. Bellarmine was nationally ranked for the vast majority of the season, and Galvin earned All-America honors.

In 2015-16, Dugan's squad returned to the prominence not witnessed in the program since the 1990s, tying the program record for best win percentage in a season (85.7) after finishing 24-4. The Knights' 15-3 mark in the GLVC tied its best output among its 18-game conference seasons. Dugan guided Bellarmine to an unprecedented GLVC Tournament championship after her squad upset No. 10 Drury, 80-77, in the semifinals and claimed the title with an 89-78 victory over No. 22 Quincy in the finals. That set the stage for a Selection Sunday in which it was announced that Bellarmine earned its first NCAA II Tournament berth since 2008. The Knights entered the Big Dance ranked 20th in the nation.

Dugan made an immediate impact on the team in her first season. Inheriting a program coming off two losing seasons, she turned the Knights around in 2012-13 and led the team to a 19-11 record that included a 10-1 start to her tenure.

Dugan, a Sacred Heart Academy graduate, spent 13 seasons as head coach at Florida Atlantic University before taking the helm at Bellarmine. At FAU, she led the Owls to their respective conference postseason tournament each year. In 2005-06, FAU captured the Atlantic Sun championship and earned the conference's automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament.

Prior to her stint at FAU, Dugan was head coach at GLVC rival Southern Indiana, where she coached the Screaming Eagles to four NCAA Tournament appearances in eight seasons from 1991-99 including an appearance in the 1997 NCAA Division II national championship game.

Dugan guided USI to a 30-2 record in 1997 that included 29 straight wins.

In 1997-98, Dugan picked up GLVC Coach of the Year honors for the second consecutive season, leading USI to another regular-season title and capturing the inaugural GLVC Tournament at Roberts Stadium in Evansville, Indiana.

Dugan's players have accumulated a combined four conference Player of the Year, one Defensive Player of the Year and two Freshman of the Year awards (GLVC, TAAC/Atlantic Sun, Sun Belt).

A four-year letter winner for Eastern Kentucky University (1978-82), Dugan was a three-year starter and finished her junior and senior seasons as the Lady Colonels' leading rebounder and second-leading scorer. She earned a bachelor of science in physical education from EKU and a master of arts in physical education from Morehead State University.
