BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- The second night of the 14th annual Big Ten/ACC Challenge tips off Thursday with eight more games, six of which feature at least one Top 25 teams and seven that will be broadcast on linear television. Thursday's Challenge schedule is highlighted a pair of top-15 contests at 7 p.m. (ET) as No. 6/6 Indiana hosts No. 2/3 NC State (ESPN2) and No. 12/9 Michigan visits No. 10/5 Louisville (ESPN). No. 9/12 Iowa is also in action at Duke on ESPN (9 p.m. ET), while Big Ten Network and the FOX Sports app have their own Challenge twinbill with Michigan State welcoming No. 24/25 Notre Dame (6 p.m. ET) and No. 8/8 Maryland entertaining Miami (Fla.) (8 p.m. ET). As a reminder, fans are invited to join the social media conversation for this year's Big Ten/ACC Challenge through the event's official hashtag (#WB1GACC).
- The ACC holds a 4-2 edge in this year's Challenge following Wednesday's action which resulted in five of the six games decided by 10 points or less, including Purdue's buzzer-beating 53-52 win over Georgia Tech. This continues to follow the event's recent trend of highly-competitive matchups — in the last four Challenges (2017-19, 2021), nearly 65 percent of the games played (31 of 48) have been decided by 11 points or fewer, including nine decided by one possession and two that have gone to overtime (2018 - Clemson def. Illinois, 69-67; 2019 - Michigan def. Syracuse, 84-76).
- Nebraska remains unbeaten this season at 8-0 following Wednesday's 86-60 win at Wake Forest. The Huskers are off to their best start since 2009-10 (when they opened with 30 consecutive wins en route to a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament), and have put together their first eight-game winning streak since Jan. 20-Feb. 28, 2013.
- Purdue's Jeanae Terry banked in a runner in the lane as time expired to give the Boilermakers a nationally-televised 53-52 win over Georgia Tech on Wednesday at Mackey Arena. It was Purdue's first buzzer-beating victory since Feb. 13, 2020, when Dominique Oden hit a three-pointer to defeat Wisconsin. It also gave the Boilermakers their third win in as many tries against a former Purdue head coach (Georgia Tech is led by Nell Fortner, who was named Big Ten Coach of the Year in 1996-97 after leading the Boilermakers to the Big Ten title during her lone season in West Lafayette).
- Maryland comes into Thursday's Big Ten/ACC Challenge matchup with Miami sharing the nation's longest active home winning streak (28 games) with Stephen F. Austin. The Terrapins, whose current run began Nov. 17, 2019, with a victory over Delaware at the XFinity Center, have a way's to go to catch their school record of 48 consecutive home wins from 2007-10.
- In the most recent Big Ten/ACC Challenge in 2019 (the 2020 event was cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic), the Big Ten clinched its first-ever win with a 9-5 victory that was fueled, in part, by a perfect 5-0 start on the first night. The Big Ten, which won all seven of its home games in the 2019 event, also added road wins by Indiana (at No. 22/21 Miami) and Minnesota (at Notre Dame, handing the Fighting Irish their first loss in seven Challenge appearances). The Big Ten had previously secured three ties in the Challenge (6-6 in 2011, 7-7 in 2014 and 2015) before its 2019 outright victory. The Big Ten schools with the most success in the Challenge have been Maryland (11-2 all-time, including a 4-2 record as a Big Ten member), Michigan (9-4) and Indiana (8-5).
- On Monday, the ACC, Big Ten, and Pac-12 announced a joint initiative entitled "Teammates for Mental Health," which is designed to raise awareness about the importance of mental health and wellness among their more than 27,000 student athletes. This initiative builds upon the work all three conferences continue to dedicate toward mental health, including the creation of dedicated task forces and cabinets comprised of mental health professionals on campuses at the 41 world-class institutions that comprise the ACC, Big Ten, and Pac-12. The Alliance officially tipped off Teammates for Mental Health with this week's Big Ten/ACC Women's and Men's Basketball Challenges, along with Alliance basketball matchups during the regular season across all three conferences. These Alliance matchups — and others throughout the 2021-22 ACC, Big Ten, and Pac-12 college athletics seasons — will highlight the importance of mental health and wellness.

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.

- The Alliance's Teammates for Mental Health initiative includes a public service announcement (PSA) featuring women's and men's basketball head coaches and the commissioners from all three conferences. The 30-second PSA will air on ESPN, ACC Network, Big Ten Network, and Pac-12 Networks, as well as on conference-owned digital and social media channels. Additionally, starting with the 2021 Big Ten/ACC Women's and Men's Basketball Challenges, Alliance games will feature Teammates for Mental Health public address announcements, digital signage, coaches' lapel pins, and promotions that help serve fans' mental health and wellness needs.
- This is the fourth consecutive week the Big Ten leads the nation with five AP Top 25 teams (all in top 20), including three teams ranked among the AP top 10. Indiana leads the Big Ten contingent at No. 6, with Maryland at No. 8 and Iowa at No. 9. Michigan remains at No. 12 while Ohio State rose to No. 18 and Purdue is receiving votes.
- In the latest Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA)/USA Today poll, the Big Ten is tied for the national lead with five Top 25 teams, including three top-10 programs (and a fourth at No. 12). Indiana leads the way at No. 6, with Maryland at No. 8 and Michigan at No. 9. Iowa is next at No. 12, followed by No. 20 Ohio State.
- Purdue captured its first win over a ranked opponent in nearly three years on Nov. 27 with a 66-61 victory over No. 17/22 Florida State at the Global Sports & Events St. Pete Showcase in St. Petersburg, Fla. The Boilermakers' last Top 25 win came on Jan. 20, 2019, a 56-53 decision over No. 25 Indiana, and their last victory over a team ranked 17th or higher in the Associated Press poll was Feb. 15, 2018, a 75-65 win at No. 10 Maryland.
- Michigan's Kim Barnes Arico collected her 200th victory in Ann Arbor on Nov. 27 with a 64-48 win over Mississippi State at the Daytona Beach (Fla.) Invitational. Barnes Arico, who is the winningest coach in Michigan women's basketball history (200-102, .662 in 10 seasons), is just the third Wolverine basketball coach (women's or men's) to reach the 200-win milestone at the school, joining John Beilein (278 from 2007-19) and Johnny Orr (209 from 1968-80).
- Ohio State carved a place in the Big Ten record books on Nov. 23, scoring 70 points in the first half of its 110-58 victory over Bellarmine. The Buckeyes broke the previous conference record for points in a half (69) that had been set on two prior occasions — Dec. 5, 1982 (Wisconsin vs. Bradley) and Nov. 23, 2002 (Minnesota vs. Purdue Fort Wayne). In both cases, those points came in the second half, with the old Big Ten first half scoring record being 68 points, also twice before — Dec. 8, 1990 (Purdue vs. Kent State) and Feb. 23, 2021 (Maryland vs. Iowa).
- With its win over Bellarmine, Ohio State became the fifth different Big Ten team to score 100 points in a game this season, joining Maryland, Michigan State, Nebraska (three times) and Penn State. It's the third year in a row the Big Ten has had at least four programs reach triple digits in the same season — the 2019-20 campaign was the last time the conference had more 100-point scoring teams, with seven Big Ten programs reaching the century mark at least once that season.
- The Big Ten announced Nov. 18 that Megan Kahn has been named Vice President of Women's Basketball. Kahn will work with Commissioner Kevin Warren and Deputy Commissioner/Chief Sports Officer Diana Sabau to lead the women's basketball efforts for the conference. She will be charged with developing a cohesive strategy to strengthen, enhance and expand the Big Ten women's basketball operations, brand and strategic initiatives. Kahn comes to the conference following a successful tenure at WeCOACH, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization committed to the educational and professional development of women's coaches across all sports and levels. She also previously served as assistant and associate commissioner at the Atlantic 10 Conference (2008-12) and was tournament manager for game operations at the 2015 and 2019 NCAA Women's Final Fours that were played in Tampa, Fla.

Since its inception in 1896, the pursuit and attainment of academic excellence has been a priority for every Big Ten member institution. But maintaining the conference's standard of competing at the highest level in athletics also endures as an important component of the Big Ten experience. Striking that balance between academics and athletics is integral to the Big Ten's identity. Recognized as one of intercollegiate sports' most successful undertakings, the Big Ten strives for success from its students not only on the field and in the classroom, but around the world as well.

PREMIER ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS

The Big Ten Academic Alliance is an academic consortium of all 14 Big Ten universities, which is widely considered to be the model for effective and voluntary collaboration among top research universities.

Every Big Ten Academic Alliance institution ranks among the top 70 universities in the nation according to the 2021 Academic Ranking of World Universities, including six in the top 30.

The Big Ten leads all conferences with more than 1,800 Academic All-Americans, including a Big Ten-record 56 honorees during the 2020-21 academic year.

Big Ten Academic Alliance schools annually conduct \$10 billion in funded research, \$5 billion more than any other conference.

A HISTORY OF ATHLETIC SUCCESS

Big Ten schools have won at least five national championships in 23 of the last 27 years, averaging nearly seven per year during that span.

Since the 2008-09 academic year, current Big Ten institutions have claimed 80 team national championships in 22 different sports.

BROAD-BASED PROGRAMMING

The Big Ten will administer more than \$240 million in direct financial support to more than 9,800 students competing in intercollegiate athletics for more than 11,000 participation opportunities on 350 teams in 42 different sports.

The Big Ten sponsors 28 official conference sports, 14 for men and 14 for women, including the addition of men's ice hockey and men's and women's lacrosse in this decade.

The Big Ten leads the nation in total students competing in intercollegiate athletics and participation opportunities, and sponsors more official sports than all conferences except the Ivy League.

More than 1,500 Big Ten competitors have participated in the Olympics, winning more than 500 medals, including more than 200 gold. The Big Ten Conference enjoyed its finest performance at a single Olympic Games during the 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo, Japan, as athletes with Big Ten ties set conference records by earning 51 total medals and 22 gold medals during the 17-day competition. All 14 Big Ten member schools had an athlete win at least one medal in Tokyo, also a first in conference history.

PASSIONATE FOLLOWING

The Big Ten leads all conferences with 6.4 million alumni and nearly 580,000 students.

Each year more than 11 million patrons attend Big Ten home contests, as the conference has led the nation in attendance for men's basketball, ice hockey, volleyball and wrestling.

LEADERS IN INNOVATION

Took part in the nation's first bowl game, winning the 1902 Rose Bowl Game, and signed an exclusive contract with the Tournament of Roses in 1946, making it the first bowl with permanent conference affiliations.

Awarded the first Big Ten Medal of Honor in 1915, honoring outstanding seniors who demonstrated excellence in academics and athletics.

Formed the Big Ten Advisory Commission in 1972, enlisting former students that competed in conference athletics to serve as liaisons to the NCAA's Diversity and Inclusion Department, the Big Ten Student-Athlete Advisory Commission and other organizations.

Became the first conference to voluntarily adopt male and female participation goals after launching its Gender Equity Action Plan in 1992.

Implemented the first collegiate football system of instant replay in 2004, which the NCAA approved for use among all conferences in 2006.

Launched the Big Ten Network (BTN) in 2007, the first national conference-owned television network.

Began partnering with the Ivy League to study the effects of head injuries in sports in 2012.

Accepted Johns Hopkins University as the conference's first sport affiliate members in men's and women's lacrosse in 2013 and 2015, respectively, and added Notre Dame as a sport affiliate member in men's ice hockey in 2017.

EXTENSIVE TELEVISION EXPOSURE

Through the Big Ten's current media agreements with BTN, ABC/ESPN, CBS and FOX, more than 2,000 Big Ten events are produced and distributed nationally and globally on an annual basis.

BTN is in almost 60 million homes across the United States and Canada, and is also available via the Fox Sports App, delivering live and on-demand programming to computers, smartphones and tablets. B1G+ streams hundreds of additional events each season.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

For more than 30 years, through the Big Ten's SCORE (Success Comes Out of Reading Everyday) program, the conference has partnered with Chicago elementary schools to improve reading performance.

Surrounding the Big Ten Football Championship Game and Basketball Tournaments, the conference has held numerous community initiatives, partnered with the College Football Playoff Foundation and other events such as the Big Ten Career Expo, SaturDAY of Service and Youth Football Clinics. In addition, the Big Ten has hosted a downtown 5K, collaborated with a local breast cancer awareness group and provided unique event experiences for military veterans.
