## GETTING STARTED

### PERRONI EMERGING

Junior Nicole Perroni has 19 goals in the first six games this season, which ranks fifth in the ACC and seventh in the NCAA. She also has 17 draw controls. She had a career-high five goals on nine shots in the season-opener at Colorado. She entered the season with 10 goals and 11 draw controls in 18 games for her career.

### HANNAH MORRIS RANKS SECOND ON TEAM IN CAREER GOALS

Senior Hannah Morris is tied for first with 19 goals this season, which ranks fifth in the ACC and seventh in the NCAA. She has netted 15 goals during the homestand, including two four goal performances against Marquette and Butler. She has 69 career goals, which is second on the team to Caroline Blalock's 117. She had a team-high 21 goals as a sophomore in 2020 and 25 goals as a junior last season.

### WINNING THE DRAW

Louisville has won the draw in each of its six games this season and its 17.7 draws per game rank third in the ACC and seventh in the NCAA. They have recorded at least 17 draw controls in every game this season and are winning the draw control battle, 106-73.

### McKEE THRIVING IN THE DRAW CIRCLE

Junior Madi McKee has been an anchor for the Cardinals in the draw. She has 38 draw controls and her 6.3 draws per game rank fourth in the ACC and 24th in the country.

■ McKee's 13 draw controls vs. Central Michigan, is tied for the sixth most in program history, and is the most in school history for a player not named Kaylin Morissette. Morissette, in her fifth season as an assistant coach at UofL, holds the all-time record with 18 draw controls at Longwood on 3/25/15 and recorded 13-plus draw controls nine times in her career.

### MULTI-GOAL CARDS

Louisville has three a trio of Cardinals who have scored multiple goals in six straight games this season in Caroline Blalock, Hannah Morris and Nicole Perroni. Allegra Catalano has three multi-goal games and Kokoro Nakazawa and Paige Richbourg have each recorded multiple goals in two games. Madi McKee, Bella Karstien and Isabella Rulapaugh have one such game.

### HOT START AT HOME

UofL is off to a 4-0 start at home this season after beating Marquette (2/18), Central Michigan (2/20), Virginia Tech (2/26) and Butler (3/1). The Cardinals have won their first four home games for the first time since 2017 when they got off to a 6-0 start at UofL Lacrosse Stadium.

### WINNING WAYS


Louisville's current four game winning streak is the first four-game winning streak since 2016 when the Cardinals won five straight from March 16 to March 30 and is the longest streak under head coach Scott Teeter.

### STRENGTH OF THE ACC

UofL is 1-0 in the ACC to start the season after defeating Virginia Tech 14-11 on 2/26. With a win vs. Boston College on Saturday, Louisville would kick off their ACC slate with a 2-0 record for the first time since 2016 when the Cardinals started 2-0 after wins over No. 14 Boston College (2/27) and No. 4 Notre Dame (3/5).

**ABOUT THE EAGLES**

The Eagles are off to a 5-0 start this season with three wins against top 25 opponents. Last season, Boston College finished with an 18-3 record, 8-2 in the ACC, and capped off the year winning the National Championship. The Eagles enter Saturday's game coming off a 15-9 win at Brown. BC returns its leading scorer and 2021 Tewaaraton Award winner Charlotte North, who is second in the ACC and NCAA with 29 goals on the year and is leading the nation with 5.5 goals per game. The Eagles also return their three-year starting goalie in Rachel Hall. Hall has 21 saves in the team's five games with a .339 save percentage.

**Series History** - Louisville is 1-8 all-time against Boston College, 1-1 at home, 0-6 at BC and 0-1 at neutral sites. In the first of two meetings last season, the Cardinals lost a 14-13 heartbreaker in overtime, holding Charlotte North to just one goal in the contest.

**Last Meeting (March 8, 2021)** - Three Cardinals scored a goal apiece as Louisville fell 18-3 at Boston College.

**WALLING UP NORTH**

Last season, the Cardinals and the Eagles played twice in the same weekend. In game one, Louisville limited BC's leading scorer Charlotte North to just one goal in a 14-13 OT loss. Two days later, UofL locked North up, not allowing her to score for the first time in her career at Boston College.

**THE CAPTAINS**

Graduate students Caroline Blalock and Sarah Blalock, senior Kirsten Parker and juniors Maggie Foster and Sydney Kirchenheiter will serve as captains for the 2022 season. It marks the fifth season Caroline Blalock will serve as a captain and the second season for Sarah Blalock.

Caroline Blalock has been a captain since first stepping foot on campus. Last season, she was named IWLCA All-Region Second team and All-ACC Second team after leading the team with 11 assists, 32 ground balls, 39 draw controls and 21 caused turnovers.

Sarah Blalock was named to the IWLCA All-Region Second Team last season after recording 12 ground balls and 10 caused turnovers and is considered one of the best defenders in the country. Parker has appeared in 34 games, making five starts in three years. She has recorded six goals, three assists, seven caused turnovers and 15 draw controls as a Cardinal.

Kirchenheiter played in all 16 games with 12 starts as a sophomore in 2021. She finished the season with nine ground balls, seven caused turnovers and one draw control. As a freshman, she played in all nine games, starting two, and tallied eight ground balls, two caused turnovers and one draw control.

Maggie started all 16 games as a sophomore last season. She finished with 23 ground balls and nine caused turnovers, recording at least one ground ball in 12 of 16 games. As a freshman, Foster played in all nine games, starting eight, and tallied 15 ground balls, five caused turnovers and one draw control in the shortened season.

**LOUISVILLE HITS 3,000**

In the win over Virginia Tech, Caroline Blalock netted the 3,000th goal in Louisville Lacrosse's 15th season of competition.

**IN THE POLLS**

In the initial US Lacrosse Magazine Top 20 poll, Louisville was just outside of the Top 20 and second amongst teams receiving votes.

Louisville was ranked No. 21 by US Lacrosse Magazine in its annual early Early Top 25 column. The Cards turned in a 5-11 record last season, but earned the ranking for their marked improvement in the ACC, the toughest league in women's lacrosse.

After a 12-9 victory over No. 24 Colorado on Feb. 18, 2021, the Cardinals moved into the Intercollegiate Women's Lacrosse Coaches Association Top 25 poll at No. 23, marking the first time that Louisville had been ranked in the IWLCA poll since they concluded the 2017 season at No. 20. They remained in both the IWLCA and ILWomen polls the remainder of the season.

**RANKED VS. UNRANKED**

This season, the Cardinals are 4-1 against unranked teams and 0-1 against ranked teams. UofL went 1-11 against ranked teams and 4-0 against unranked teams last season. Over the last four seasons, UofL is 18-5 against unranked teams and 1-25 against ranked teams.

**GETTING ON THE BOARD FIRST**

Louisville is 4-1 this season when scoring first. The lone loss came in the heartbreaking 14-13 OT loss at Colorado to start the season. Last season, the Cards were 5-1 when scoring first and 0-10 when not. Over the past four seasons, UofL is 15-5 when scoring first and 4-25 when not.

**REPLACING RACHEL FLOREK**

The Cardinals will have new faces in sophomore Sara Addeche and freshman J Pleck in goal this season, as they look to fill the void left by three-year starter Rachel Florek. Florek was a stone wall between the pipes, ending her career with the most saves in UofL history with 348, and ranking sixth with a 12.76 goals allowed average, third with a .426 save percentage and fourth with 15 wins.

**CARDINALS EXCEL IN THE CLASSROOM**

The University of Louisville lacrosse team completed a successful fall semester in the classroom, posting a 3.615 team grade-point average. In addition, 29 earned Red & Black Scholar Athlete status for a 3.25 or better cumulative GPA, while eight players were named to Dean's Scholars for a perfect 4.0 GPA.

**BERGAN FOLEY INDUCTED INTO UOFL ATHLETICS HALL OF FAME**

Foley is the first women's lacrosse player inducted to UofL's Athletics Hall of Fame. She was a prolific scorer, setting the Louisville single-season record with 78 goals in 2011 and her 65 goals scored in 2011 ranks fourth all-time at UofL. Foley is the all-time leader in career goals (265), goals per game (4.08), points (288) and points per game (4.43) and her 265 career goals still ranks seventh all-time in the NCAA.

**HEAD COACH SCOTT TEETER**

Scott Teeter is in his fifth season as the head coach at Louisville and his 20th overall after spending the first 15 years at Canisius. Prior to the 2022 season, he signed a contract extension through 2025.

In 2021, Louisville finished 5-11 overall against one of the most challenging schedules in history. The Cardinals played seven games against Top 5 teams and 11 against Top 10 teams. They moved into the IWLCA Top 25 following a 12-9 win over No. 24 Colorado on Feb. 18 and remained in both the IWLCA and ILWomen polls the remainder of the season.

Prior to coming to Louisville, he served as head coach at Canisius for 15 years (2003-2017). Upon his arrival in Buffalo, he took the reins of a team that had won just 11 games in the program's first seven seasons. Under his guidance, he changed the culture of the program and was named MAAC Coach of the Year in just his third season after leading the Griffis to an eight-win improvement in 2005.

In 2011, Canisius won a school-record 14 games and capped the successful campaign with the program's first MAAC Tournament title. The Griffis added postseason championships in 2012, 2013, 2014, 2016 and 2017. In the run from 2011-14, the team became the first school in MAAC history to win four straight conference titles. Canisius also claimed regular-season crowns in 2013, 2015, 2016 and 2017 after sweeping through conference foes without a loss.

He was named the league's coach of the year again in 2015, 2016 and 2017, after becoming the first three teams in MAAC history to post a perfect 8-0 regular-season record.

He left Canisius as the winningest coach in MAAC history.

In addition, Teeter has also served as head coach of the Canadian Under-19 National Team since 2009. He guided the team to a bronze-medal showing during the 2011 championship in Hannover, Germany, before earning the country's first women's field lacrosse title at the 2015 FIL World Championship in Edinburgh, Scotland. Also in 2017, Teeter led the Canadian National team to a pair of silver medals, both at the FIL World Cup held in England and the World Games in Poland.

Teeter was a four-year letter-winner for the Canisius College ice hockey team and graduated with a degree in physical education in 2002. He earned his master's degree in physical education with a concentration in sport psychology and coaching from Canisius in 2004.

Teeter and his wife, Jennifer, have one daughter, Olivia, and one son, Lucas.

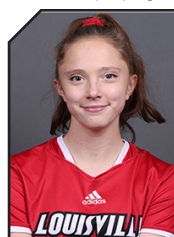
