THE SERIES

- Thursday's meeting will be the 23rd meeting of all-time between the two teams with the Cardinals owning the 20-2 lead in the series.
- Louisville is 8-2 all-time in Pittsburgh including winning seven straight.
- The Cardinals have won 16 straight in the series including a pair of victories last season.

A WIN WOULD...

- Be the Panthers' third win against Louisville all-time.
- Give Pitt their 29th ACC victory in program history.
- Give Pitt four ACC wins, tied for the second most in a season in program history.

STORYLINES

- Junior guard **Jayla Everett** has led the Panthers offensively all season long and currently ranks 9th in the ACC in scoring (15.4 ppg). She also ranks third in the ACC in three-pointers made/game (2.9) while connecting on a team-high 41 triples.
- A bright spot for the Panthers so far this season has been their rebounding, especially on the offensive glass. Pitt currently ranks second in the ACC in offensive rebounds/game (16.3 orpg) while also ranking 13th in the NCAA. In ACC play, Pitt leads the conference by grabbing 16.8 orpg.

THE OPENING TIP

- The Panthers return home on Thursday night as they welcome #3 Louisville to the Pete for a 8:00 pm tip. Thursday's game will air on the ACC Network.
- The Pitt backcourt duo of **Jayla Everett** and **Dayshanette Harris** are the fourth highest scoring backcourt in the ACC overall and in ACC games this season (28.5 ppg / 27.5 ppg - min. 11 ACC GP).
- The Pitt offense has begun to hit their stride as they have posted two ACC games with 80+ points scored, tied for the most in a season in program history. Pitt is averaging 68.0 ppg in ACC play, their highest points per game total through 11 ACC games in program history.

BY THE NUMBERS

34

The Pitt bench has been strong all season long and that continued on Tuesday as they netted 34 points from their reserves, the second most in a game this season. So far this year, Pitt's bench is averaging 22.1 ppg.

44

Junior **Jayla Everett** has taken her play to a new level over her last two games as she has posted 44 points over a two-game stretch, the most over a two-game span since joining the Panthers.

As a team, the Panthers have become strong on the offensive glass as they are grabbing an average of 16.3 offensive rebounds/game. They rank second in the ACC and 13th in the NCAA in offensive rebounds/game.

TEAM NOTES

LAST TIME OUT - AT BOSTON COLLEGE

- » The Panthers were able to break through and finish off a win on Tuesday night at Boston College, 83-80. It marked Pitt's third ACC win, their most in a season since 2016-17.
- » It marked Pitt's biggest come-from-behind victory in conference play since joining the ACC in 2013-14 (15 points). It was also their biggest comeback win overall since March, 1, 2015.
- » **Jayla Everett** led all scorers with 22 points and seven assists while **Dayshanette Harris** posted 15 points, four rebounds and three assists. **Liatu King** had a strong game with nine points, a career-high 10 points and four blocks.
- » The Panthers finished off the win with a season-high 44 points in the paint while the bench chipped in with 34 points.

THE DAY AND JAY SHOW

- » Heading into the 2020-21 campaign, the Panthers knew they would be relying on their talented guards to produce at a high level and through 14 games they haven't disappointed.
- » In the win at BC, **Dayshanette Harris** and **Jayla Everett** combined for 37 points, 10 assists, seven rebounds and one steal while going 14-32 from the floor. The two players have scored in double figures in the same game eight times this season.
- » The starting backcourt for Pitt is the fourth highest scoring guard duo overall in the ACC (28.5 ppg) as well as being the fourth highest scoring guard duo in conference games (min. 11 GP) netting 27.5 ppg combined through 11 conference games.
- » Everett or Harris have led the Panthers in scoring in 13 games this season, Everett eight times and Harris five times. Harris has scored in double digits in 11 of 14 games and in 19 of her last 22 games dating back to last year while Everett has 10+ points in 11 of the 14 games this season.

DEFENSE STEPPING UP

- » The Pitt defense has shown flashes of greatness this season but it hasn't been consistent enough yet to produce big wins.
- » Overall, Pitt is limiting their opponents to 38.5% shooting, the seventh best percentage in the ACC. The Panthers also rank fourth in blocked shots (4.4 bpg) and sixth in steals (7.5 spg).
- » Pitt held Syracuse to just 6.7% from the floor in the first quarter earlier this year, the second lowest FG% in a quarter for

a Pitt opponent since switching to the quarters format (2015-16).

- » The Panthers have held one opponent to zero field goal makes in a quarter (Loyola Chicago, 11/17/16, 3rd quarter) while holding eight others to just one make in a quarter.
- » Pitt has two of the top-10 best defensive quarters in program history this season.

PANTHERS RACKING UP THE POINTS

- » The Panthers have scored 70+ points in eight of their 14 games this season, marking the most 70+ point games in a season since 2015-16 (eight).
- » Pitt has scored 70+ points in five ACC games so far this season, the most in conference play since joining the league in 2013-14.
- » Pitt is averaging 68.0 ppg through the first 11 ACC games, the highest ppg through the first 11 ACC games in program history.
- » For just the second time in program history, the Panthers have two games with 80+ points scored (Clemson, BC) in a season. The Panthers are 6-0 when they score at least 80 points in ACC play.
- » The offense has also put together four of the best scoring quarters since the NCAA switched to the four quarter format in 2015-16. Pitt has played 668 full quarters since 2015-16 and they have four of their top-5 scoring quarters this season in their last 11 games.

ABOUT LOUISVILLE

- The Louisville Cardinals are ranked #3 in the country and own a 19-1 overall record with a 12-1 ACC mark. The Cardinals have won three straight.
- The Cardinals are led offensively by Dana Evans who is averaging an ACC-high 20.8 ppg, 4.4 apg and 2.9 rpg while connecting on 50 three-pointers.
- Kianna Smith is enjoying a good season as she ranks second in scoring (12.3 ppg) while adding in 3.7 rpg and 2.0 apg.
- The freshman duo of Olivia Cochran and Hailey Van Lith are making an immediate impact. Cochran is averaging 11.5 ppg and 6.8 rpg while Van Lith is averaging 11.3 ppg, 5.4 rpg and 2.0 apg.
- As a team, Louisville is averaging 81.7 ppg while allowing 62.5 ppg.

HEY DAY DAY

- » Sophomore **Dayshanette Harris** made her 38th career start last time out against Boston College and she finished with 15 points, four rebounds and three assists in 25 minutes of work.
- » Harris has led the Panthers in scoring five times this year and 18 times in her career. She has also scored in double figures in 11 of 14 games this season and in 19 of her last 22 games dating back to last season.
- » She is the first Panther since Yacine Diop in 2017-18 to score 10+ points in six straight games to start the season.
- » Harris is enjoying a career year so far as she is averaging 28.6 minutes, 13.1 points, 5.0 assists, 4.6 rebounds and 1.4 steals. Her 5.0 apg ranks third in the ACC.
- » In ACC games, Harris is averaging 13.5 ppg to go along with 5.0 apg. The sophomore also ranks fourth in the ACC in free throw percentage (36-for-42, 85.7%). She has made 15 of her last 16 free throws dating back to the Virginia Tech game.
- » She has shot at least 50% from the floor four times this year after doing so just twice during her freshman season.
- » Harris has recorded at least five assists in eight games this season after only posting four such games a season ago.

EVERETT EXCELLING IN NEW HOME

- » After earning immediate eligibility following her transfer from New Mexico, **Jayla Everett** has made a huge impact for the Panthers through 14 games.
- » The St. Louis, MO product is enjoying a great start to her Pitt career as she is averaging 31.0 mpg, 15.4 ppg, 2.1 rpg and 2.9 apg while shooting 36.6% from behind the arc through 14 games.
- » Everett is currently 9th in the ACC in scoring (15.4 ppg), 13th in three-point field goal percentage (36.6%), 8th in free throw percentage (78.0%) and third in three-pointers made/game (2.9).
- » Last time out against Boston College, Everett finished with her second straight 22-point game to go along with a season-high seven assists. 15 of her 22 points came in the second half, a half in which Pitt entered trailing by 10.
- » Everett currently ranks 21st in the NCAA in three-pointers made/game (2.9) while becoming the first Panther in program to net at least two triples in each of the first eight games of the season.
- » Through her first eight games as a Panther she connected on 29 three-pointers which were the most makes through the first eight games of a season by a Pitt player in program history.

TEAM NOTES...

- » Everett is the first Pitt player in over 20 seasons to net at least 16 points in each of the first five games of the season.
- » For her career, Everett has 43 games scoring in double figures including 12 games with 20+ points scored.
- » She has made three or more three-pointers in 10 games this season and in 22 games over her career.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU

- » Sophomore forward **Amber Brown** has started all 44 career games for the Panthers and does a little bit of everything to help Pitt succeed.
- » Brown posted 10 points and seven rebounds in her last game. It marked her fourth game in the last five with 10+ points scored.
- » Earlier this season, Brown became the second fastest player to 300 career rebounds (Brenna Wise - 40 games) since Pitt joined the ACC in 2013-14.
- » On the season, Brown is averaging 7.6 points, 6.5 rebounds and 1.5 assists while shooting a career-best 51.5% from the floor.
- » She has 22 career double digit scoring games and 11 career games with 10 or more rebounds.
- » Brown has posted 20+ minutes played in 44 of 45 career games while leading the Panthers in rebounding a team-best 20 times over her career.
- » Through her first 45 career games, Brown has played 1,352 minutes, the most by a Pitt player in their first 45 career games since Pitt joined the ACC in 2013-14.

BENCH PROVIDING PRODUCTION

- » The Pitt bench continued to produce on Tuesday as **Destiny Strother** netted 11 points, **Liatu King** finished with nine points and **Cynthia Ezeja** had six. The Panthers scored 34 bench points total in the road win.
- » The Pitt bench posted a season-high 39 points in the win over Clemson, the most in a game by the Pitt bench since scoring 47 against New Orleans on Nov. 9, 2018.
- » **Liatu King** and **Destiny Strother** each scored 15 points in the win over Clemson. It marked the first time Pitt had two players score at least 15 points each off the bench since Feb. 2, 2017 against Syracuse when Alayna Gribble (23) and Kalista Walters (17) accomplished the feat.
- » So far this season, the Pitt bench is averaging 22.1 points/game. It is an increase of +8.1 ppg from a season ago off the bench.

HITTING THE OFFENSIVE GLASS

- » The Panthers have done a great job over the last two seasons of attacking the offensive glass.
- » Last time out, Pitt snagged 19 offensive rebounds. They have seven straight games with 15+.
- » Pitt has two games with 20+ offensive rebounds this season.
- » The Panthers have upped their production on the offensive glass this season as they rank second overall (16.3 orpg) and first in ACC games (16.9 orpg).
- » The Panthers currently rank 13th in the NCAA in offensive rebounds/game (16.3 orpg).
- » Pitt has a pair of forwards who rank inside the top-7 in the ACC in offensive rebounds/game in conference games. **Cynthia Ezeja** ranks fifth (3.0 orpg) and **Rita Igbokwe** ranks seventh (2.9 orpg).

2019-20 HIGHLIGHTS

- » The Panthers had a strong close to their 2019-20 campaign as they collected just the second ACC Tournament win in program history as they downed Notre Dame, 67-65, in the first round behind a **Dayshanette Harris** game-winning runner in the lane.
- » One of the brightest spots for the Panthers a season ago was the play of coach White's first recruiting class, **Dayshanette Harris, Amber Brown, Rita Igbokwe** and **Emy Hayford**.
- » The freshman quartet etched their names in the Pitt record book as they became the highest scoring freshman class in program history (948 points combined). The 948 points combined also ranked third amongst Power 5 conference freshman classes in scoring, trailing only USC (1,308 points) and South Carolina (1,047; #1 recruiting class in the NCAA).
- » Pitt was one of two Power 5 conference teams a season ago to have four freshman average at least 19.5 minutes/game (Cal).
- » Guard **Dayshanette Harris** burst onto the scene for the Panthers down the stretch and she finished the year as the only freshman from a Power 5 conference school to lead her team in scoring, assists and steals. Harris was the lone Power 5 conference freshman to average at least 12.5 ppg, 4.5 rpg and 1.8 spg a season ago.
- » Harris earned a spot on the All-ACC Freshman Team following her strong first season as a Panther. She is just the second Pitt player in program history (Brenna Wise, 2016) to earn a spot on the All-ACC Freshman Team.
- » The dynamic freshman rebounding duo of **Amber Brown** (7.7 rpg - led all ACC freshman) and **Rita Igbokwe** (6.8 rpg) were the third best rebounding freshman duo in the NCAA (14.5 rpg combined). Brown and Igbokwe were one of only two freshman duos in the NCAA (Oregon State) to average at least 6.8 rpg each.
- » Brown earned ACC Freshman of the Week honors twice during her first season as she is just the second Panther in program history to earn that recognition twice in a season (Jasmine Whitney 2016-17).
- » Brown was also the only Power 5 conference freshman to lead her team in minutes played (31.9 mpg) while averaging at least 9.1 ppg and 7.7 rpg.
- » Igbokwe burst onto the scene for the Panthers as a presence down low during her first season. The athletically-gifted Igbokwe set a Pitt freshman record for blocks in a season with 60, breaking the previous record that stood for 43 years.
- » Igbokwe was one of six Power 5 conference freshman a season ago to shoot at least 46.2% from the floor while averaging 6.8 rpg and notch at least 60 blocked shots.
- » Igbokwe had a monster game against Ohio during her freshman season in which she grabbed 18 rebounds which were the most rebounds in a game by a Pitt player since 2010 and the most by a Panther freshman since 2005 when Mercedes Walker snagged 19 boards.
- » Junior sharpshooter **Gabbie Green** exploded onto the scene for Pitt a season ago after transferring in from South Plains College in Texas. Green finished off her first season connecting on 60 three-pointers, the most triples by a junior in program history. The 60 treys are also the fourth most in a single season in program history.
- » At the conclusion of the season, Pitt placed two student-athletes (**Aysia Bugg** and **Dayshanette Harris**) on the All-ACC Academic Team. It marked the second straight season with two representatives and the ninth and tenth in program history.

LAST MEETING WITH LOUISVILLE

PITTSBURGH – The Pitt women's basketball team dropped their final home game of the season on Sunday afternoon to #5 Louisville inside the Pete, 79-47. Prior to the game on Sunday, the Panthers honored three student-athletes, Aysia Bugg, Alayna Gribble and former Pitt standout Yacine Diop who is playing her final season for the Cardinals.

After Gabbie Green opened the scoring with a deep triple on the Panthers second possession of the game, the Louisville Cardinals went on an 8-0 run to force Pitt to call their first timeout of the game. The Panthers settled in after the timeout as Rita Igbokwe and Emy Hayford finished off layups to cut the Pitt deficit to one, 8-7. Louisville knocked down a triple to take the 13-9 lead with under 10 seconds to play in the first quarter but Jahsyni Knight hit the half-court shot at the buzzer as the Panthers went to the second quarter trailing by one, 13-12.


The Cardinals were able to open the game up a bit in the second quarter as they scored the first 16 points of the quarter before Cara Judkins finished off a layup to make the score 29-14 in favor of the visitors. Dayshanette Harris then took over for the Panthers as she netted eight straight points including a pair of triples to cut the Louisville lead to nine, 31-22. The Cardinals were then able to close the first half on an 8-2 run to take the 39-24 lead into the locker room.

The third quarter was a big problem for the Panthers once again on Sunday as they were outscored 24-5 in the quarter as the Cardinals pushed their lead out to 63-29 through 30 minutes. The Panthers were held to just 2-for-15 shooting in the third while Louisville shot 55.6% in the quarter.

Pitt had a strong fourth quarter once again as they outscored the Cardinals 18-16 across the final 10 minutes of action. Green led the way in the final frame as she netted eight of her team-high 11 points as the Panthers fell in their final home game of the season 79-47.

Green led the way scoring for Pitt on Sunday as she finished with 11 points and two rebounds while connecting on three triples in the loss. Harris netted 10 points, five rebounds and two assists across 33 minutes while Igbokwe chipped in with eight points, six boards and two blocks in the loss. Amber Brown grabbed a team-high nine rebounds and three assists while Judkins grabbed five boards off the bench.

As a team, Louisville shot 48.4% from the floor while they held the Panthers to just 29.3% shooting in the loss. Pitt turned the ball over 22 times and the Cardinals netted 26 points off of those turnovers while they also held the 22-4 edge in fast break scoring.

LANCE WHITE

HEAD COACH | 3RD SEASON | TEXAS TECH '96

Lance White enters his third season at the helm of the Panthers in 2020-21 after being named as the ninth head coach in Pitt women's basketball history on April 19, 2018.

In White's second season in charge, the Panthers showed growth in every part of the program and it was capped with an ACC Tournament victory over the defending ACC Champions, Notre Dame. The win over the Irish marked just the Panthers second ACC Tournament win in program history as freshman sensation Dayshannette Harris knocked down the game-winning jumper with just 2.7 seconds left in the game. With the win, Pitt handed Notre Dame just their second loss in ACC Tournament history.

The foundation for the Pitt program was laid in season two as White's "First Class" of seven student-athletes made huge impacts that will shape the program for years to come. The Pitt freshman class of Harris, Amber Brown, Emy Hayford and Rita Igbokwe was not only the best freshman class in the ACC but they were one of the best in the NCAA. The quartet averaged 31.0 points/game combined, the most ever by a Pitt freshman class.

The youthful Panthers roster during the 2019-20 campaign was able to get loads of experience that will help down the road as Pitt was the only team in the ACC to start five newcomers, doing so in the final seven games of the season.

White signed his highest ranking recruiting class for the 2020-21 campaign as he will have five newcomers to the lineup, three freshman and two transfer student-athletes. The three freshman joining the program are Tracey Hueston, the 73rd ranked recruit in the 2020 class, Liatu King and Taisha Exanor. Hueston is the highest rated recruit for the Panthers since joining the ACC while King and Exanor are both three-star prospects with winning pedigrees.

Also joining the 2020 class will be New Mexico transfer Jayla Everett who earned the Mountain West Freshman of the Year accolades in 2018-19 after coming out of Kirkwood High School ranked as the 94th best player in the 2018 class. Sophomore Destiny Strother also transferred to Pitt after one year at Marquette, helping the Eagles to a 24-8 record while coming off the bench.

Off the court, the 2019-20 Panthers posted their best semester in the classroom since joining the ACC as they posted a team cumulative GPA of 3.481. Pitt also saw two student-athletes, Aysia Bugg and Harris, earn ACC All-Academic Team honors for the second straight season.

White notched his first career head coaching victory in the Panthers second game of the season on Nov. 9, 2018 as he led Pitt to the dominant 90-38 victory over New Orleans, their seventh largest defeat in program history and their largest in over a decade.

White collected his first ACC victory on Feb. 14, 2019 when the Panthers knocked off the North Carolina Tar Heels inside the Petersen Events Center, 91-78. The 91 points scored for the Panthers were their most scored in a game since 2014 and their most ever in an ACC contest. Another historic win for the Panthers during White's first season was the road victory over Duquesne in the City Game as they downed the Dukes by the score of 66-58.

With White at the helm, Pitt upped its offensive efficiency as they had four players average over 9.5 points/game including leading scorer Danielle Garven who finished off her impressive senior campaign averaging a career-high 11.8 points and 4.3 rebounds. Fellow senior Cassidy Walsh also had a great season under White's watchful eye as she quadrupled her scoring production from her junior season, averaging a career-high 9.7 points/game for the Panthers. Pitt also posted the fourth best season in school history from behind the arc as they connected on 32.7% from behind the arc while also bumping up their rebounding average to 35.5 rebounds/game.

Off the court, White had a pair of student-athletes, Jasmine Whitney and Cassidy Walsh, named to the All-ACC Academic Team, the most for Pitt since 2015 when they placed three on the team.

White came to Pitt after spending 15 years at Florida State, where he helped the Seminoles to a 350-145 (.707) record, including 12 seasons of 20+ wins.

During his final season at Florida State (2017-18), the Seminoles posted 25 or more wins for the fourth consecutive season, finishing with a 26-7 overall record and averaged the second-most points in a season in program history with 81.0 points per game. It was just the second time FSU averaged 80 or more points per game in a season. The team ranked in the Top 20 nationally in field goal percentage (20th), offensive rebounds per game (16th), rebound margin (sixth), rebounds per game (11th), scoring margin (10th) and scoring offense (13th). The Seminoles led the ACC in rebounding offense (42.8), rebounding margin (+10.0) and offensive rebounding percentage (41.4 percent).

During his time at FSU, 10 players were selected in the WNBA Draft, eight earned ACC All-Defensive team honors and 37 earned all-conference awards. He helped the Seminoles reach the NCAA Tournament in 13 of the past 14 years, while the team won at least one NCAA Tournament game in each of its past 15 appearances.

For his standout coaching efforts during the 2016-17 season, White was named the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year.

White helped FSU reach new levels of success and brought an infectious energy to the program. He directed the Seminole defense and offense during his tenure in addition to being one of the country's top recruiters. Florida State captured back-to-back regular season ACC co-titles in 2010 and 2011, and advanced to the 2010 NCAA Tournament Elite Eight. After serving as assistant coach for the first nine seasons in Tallahassee, White was promoted to associate head coach in advance of the 2012-13 campaign.

Prior to FSU, White spent 11 seasons at Texas Tech, including five years as an assistant coach with the Lady Raiders' top-10 program under legendary head coach Marsha Sharp. With White on staff, Texas Tech won three Big 12 championships and advanced to seven consecutive NCAA Tournaments, including five Sweet 16 and two Elite Eight appearances. He was a student assistant on Tech's 1993 national championship team and a graduate assistant coach for two seasons before being elevated to a full-time coach in 1998.

While in Lubbock, White worked with some of the best players the game has ever seen, including National Player of the Year and three-time WNBA MVP Sheryl Swoopes as well as Plenette Pierson, who was named 2007 WNBA Sixth Woman of the Year.

A 1996 graduate of Texas Tech, White earned his bachelor's degree in exercise and sports science. He went on to receive a master's degree in sports administration in August 1998. He attended Lubbock Christian University for three semesters before transferring to Texas Tech in January 1993.
